
Blockchain History Timeline; Live Infographic

1998

Wei Dai Proposes "B-Money"; Nick Szabo Proposes "Bit Gold". Although never implemented, these inspired Satoshi Nakamoto's Bitcoin protocol.

2000

Stefan Konst proposes Cryptographic Secure Chains; a model where entries in the chain can be traced from the genesis to prove the authenticity. ===

2004

Hal Finney Introduces Hashcash as a Reusable Proof-of-Work System; first time the concept of proof-of-work was used in a Blockchain context.

2008

Bitcoin.org domain was registered; Satoshi Nakamoto publishes Bitcoin paper. The words "Block" and "Chain" appeared separately, first time.
